Our London team has also been successful in securing our first commission with British Airways and we hope to forge a successful partnership for the future.

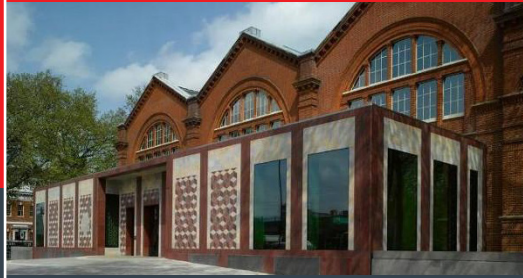
